## **Code of Conduct – Adopted March, 2002**

The purpose of the Crown Point Girls Softball League (CPGSL) is to promote, develop and regulate the game of softball on the youth level in the Crown Point Girls Softball League. The primary goals of (CPGSL) are to develop team and individual softball skills that the participants will be able to carry with them throughout their middle and high school years. - *Play by the rules and laws of the game.*

- *Never argue or complain about umpire's calls or decision.*
- *Lead in good sportsmanship examples at all times.*

- *Manage fans to avoid conflict with umpires and opposing teams*

- *Promote good sportsmanship on and off the field of play at both home and away games.*
- *Provide continuous positive reinforcement to the players that will encourage them to strive to enhance their skill level.*
- *Encourage good sportsmanship to your child, other players and coaches.*
